3. Explanation

In 2025, Martus Foundation continued its work in Kahama, Tanzania, focusing on strengthening both impact and long-term sustainability. This year, we invested in a more sustainable website and improved online presence to better communicate our mission, increase transparency, and prepare for future growth. We also faced some unexpected additional maintenance costs related to essential medical equipment used in our outreach programs. Despite these costs, we were able to continue and strengthen our activities without reducing our impact.

Throughout the year, we remained focused on maternal health and gender-based violence awareness. We supported over 800 women in monitoring their pregnancies and accessing prenatal care, and we reached hundreds of minors through our awareness campaigns.



We also further strengthened our collaboration with the local hospital in Kahama and government stakeholders, reinforcing the long-term sustainability of our work.

We are deeply grateful to our donors, partners, and volunteers for their continued trust and support. Together, we continue to improve access to healthcare for vulnerable communities in Kahama.
